REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or about 8/3/26 the Onondaga County Department of Community Development will submit a request to the HUD for the release of HOME CHDO funds to undertake a project known as 707 Otisco St for the purpose of construction of a single family home., estimated funding \$331,700.00

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

The Onondaga County Department of Community Development has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required. ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION Onondaga County Community Development certifies to HUD that J. Ryan McMahon,II in his capacity as County Executive consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. HUD's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows the name of grant recipient to use Program funds.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS HUD will accept objections to its release of funds and Onondaga County's certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of Onondaga County Community Development; (b) Onondaga County Community Development has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58; or (c) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to HUD administration office 300 Pearl St Buffalo, NY 14202. Potential objectors should contact HUD to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
