Our Services

Peer Engagement Services (PES)

A Peer is someone with lived experience of substance use and recovery who is trained to support others.

What Do Peers Do?

- Use lived experience to build trust
- Offer judgment-free support
- Share harm reduction tools and tips
- Connect people to services and resources
- Provide support during crisis or recovery steps
- Inspire hope and empowerment

Syringe Cleanup

Our team works to keep public spaces safe by regularly collecting and safely disposing of used syringes. This effort reduces health risks, prevents accidental injuries, and promotes a cleaner, healthier community.

Health Education

We provide education to help communities respond to substance use in an informed and caring way. Topics include:

- naloxone (Narcan) and overdose prevention training
- promoting stigma reduction
- prevention and harm reduction tools
- promoting community treatment and recovery services

Substance Use Crisis Response and Outreach Team

The Substance Use Crisis Response and Outreach team provides real-time peer support for substance use crises in Onondaga County.

This program offers:

- immediate assistance, support, and advocacy
- hospital accompaniment
- connection to harm reduction, prevention, treatment, and wraparound services for individuals and their support systems

Syringe Services Program (SSP)

The SSP is a confidential program that provides free sterile syringes, naloxone, test strips, and other harm reduction supplies at 7 community sites. Naloxone (Narcan) can also be obtained via our hotline, by mailing/drop off, or by picking it up at our office.

Substance Use Support Services (SUSS)

SUSS provides person-centered, and nonjudgmental case management for individuals who use drugs.

The program provides hands-on support as participants navigate systems, work towards their goals, and build pathways towards health, stability, and hope.
