About the Community Health Survey

In 2025, the Onondaga County Health Department (OCHD), in partnership with local hospitals, completed a Community Health Assessment to better understand the needs of Onondaga County residents. A critical part of the Community Health Assessment process was gathering feedback from Onondaga County residents on community health issues using a comprehensive Community Health Survey (CHS). The 2025 CHS collected a total of 1,938 eligible responses. Among the total eligible responses collected, 45.0% (n=873) were from parents or guardians to any children under 18. Some survey questions were not completed by all survey respondents, therefore, the number of respondents (n) for individual survey questions may be less than the total number of responses (n=873). All survey responses are self-reported. The results presented in this report may not reflect the entire population and should be interpreted with caution. This report presents the results of a select number of questions. Figure 1. I live in a healthy community. (n=872)

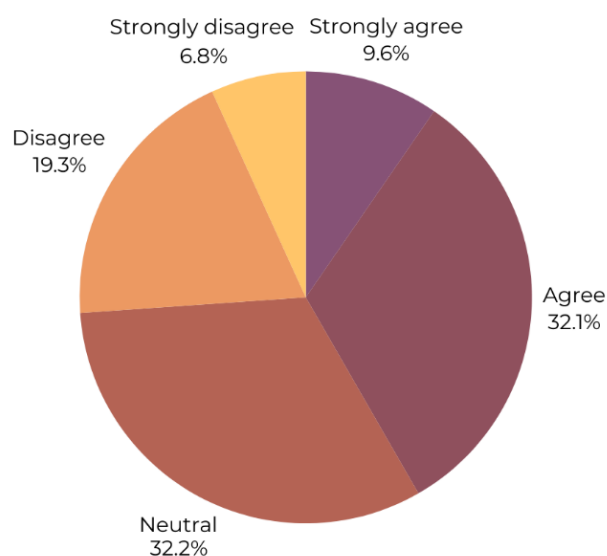


Figure 2. What areas in Onondaga County do you think need improvement? Choose your top three. (n=848)

Figure 4. In the past year, have you used community resources to help meet your basic needs? (n=870)

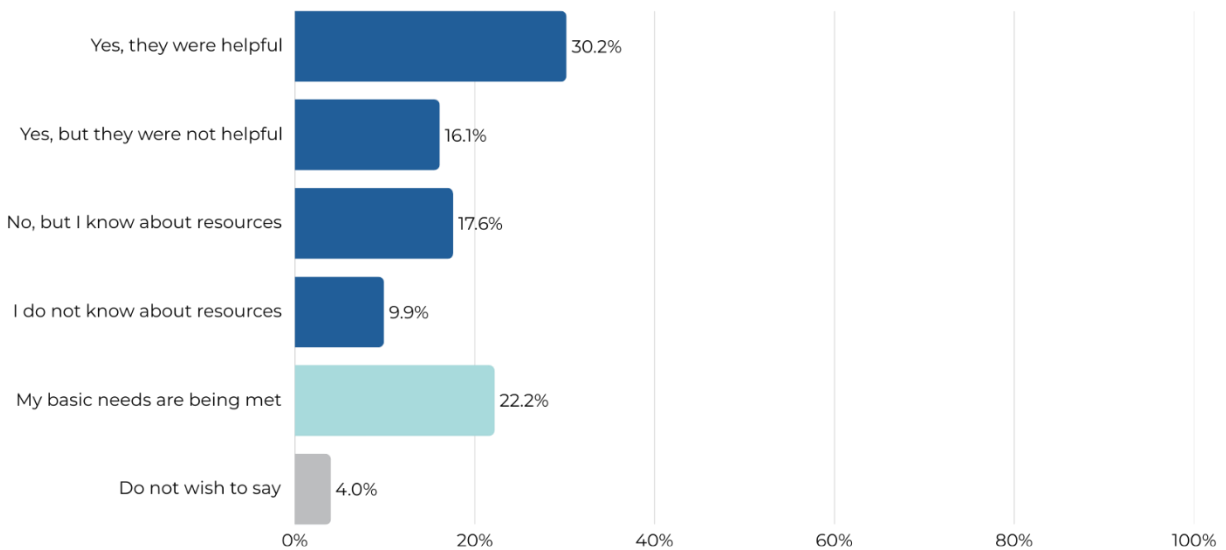


Figure 5. How would you rate your health in the past year? (n=869)

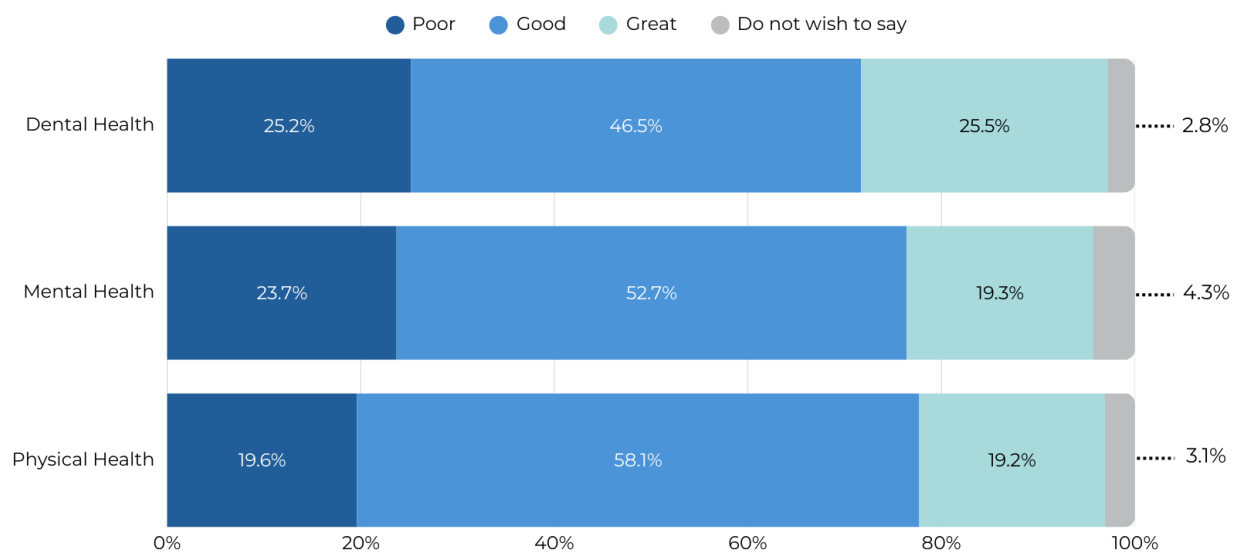


Figure 6. In the past year, was there a time when you needed healthcare but could not get it? (n=872)

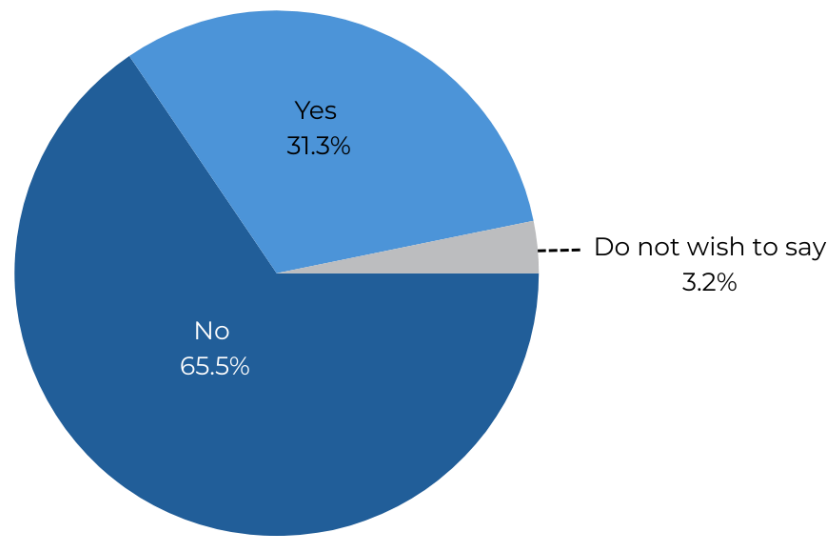
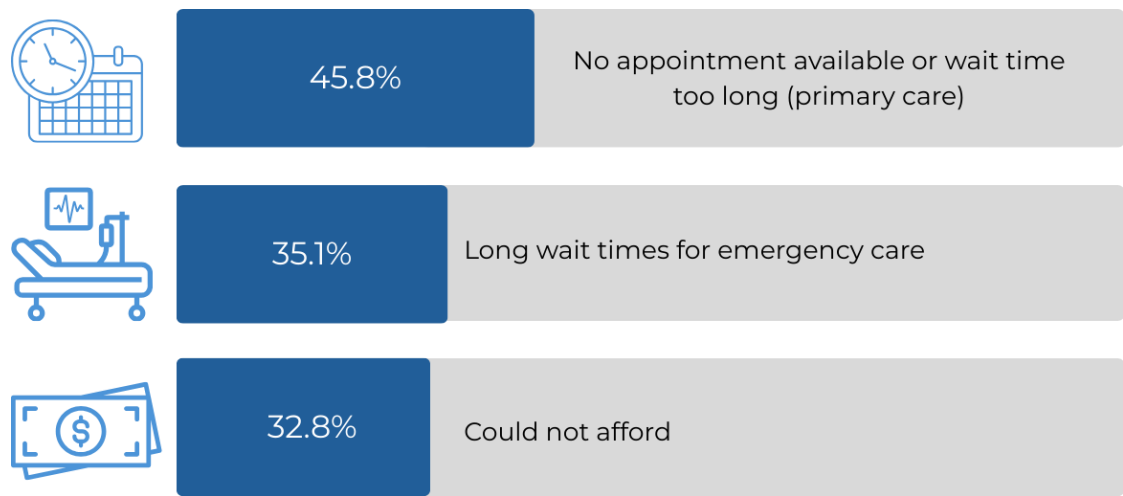
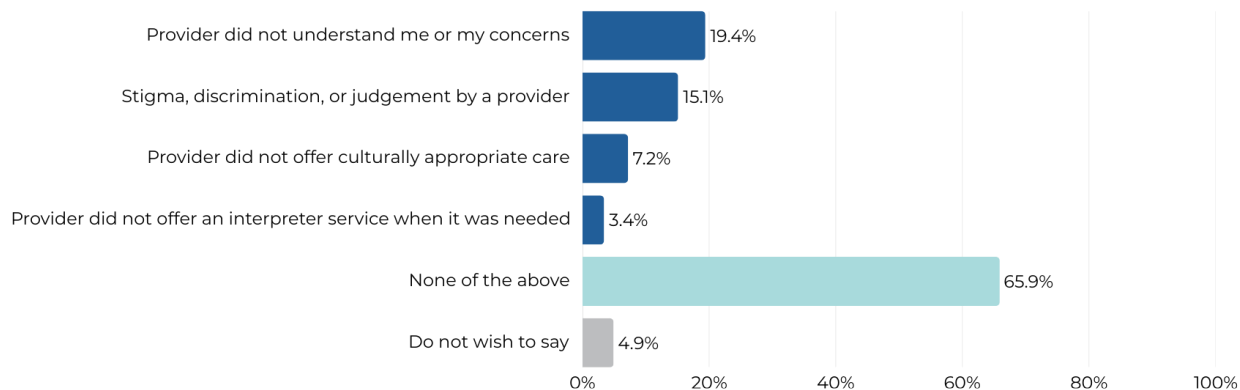


Figure 7. In the past year, which of the following factors stopped you from getting needed healthcare? Select all that apply. (n=271)



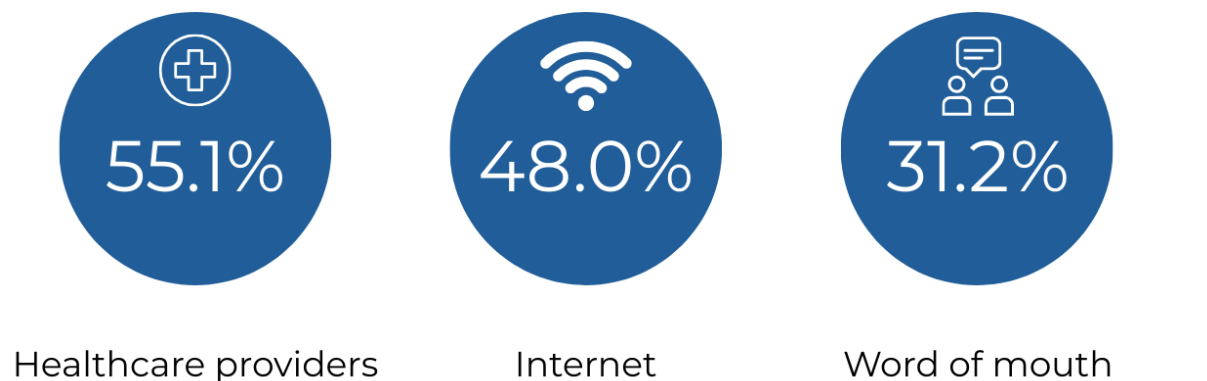
