Underserved Populations Committee Report from Dave Pasinski for April 10, 2019 Human Rights Commission Meeting

Date: April 7, 2019

The Education Committee has met two times since the new Committees were constituted. On February 27 we met to discuss about our mission and to identify our goals for the upcoming year.

The Committee identified short-term, medium-term and long-term goals and each member of the Committee is working on these goals. We met again on March 20 to report back on the progress we had made on our tasks. Below is a summary of the goals we have identified for our Committee.

Short-term Goal

The Committee's short-term goal is to continue the Committee's prior work on New York State's Dignity for All Students Act (DASA). To place our work in some context, below is a description of DASA.

DASA was signed into law in 2010 and took effect on July 1, 2012. It seeks to provide the State's public elementary and secondary school students with a safe and supportive environment free from discrimination, intimidation, taunting, harassment, and bullying on school property, a school bus and/or at a school function. DASA also amended New York State's Education Law regarding instruction in civility, citizenship, and character education by expanding the concepts of tolerance, respect for others and dignity to include: an awareness and sensitivity in the relations of people, including but not limited to, different races, weights, national origins, ethnic groups, religions, religious practices, mental or physical abilities, sexual orientations, gender identity, and sexes.

DASA further amended the Education Law to require Boards of Education to include language addressing DASA in their codes of conduct. Each school is required to identify at least one Dignity Act Coordinator (DAC). Finally, under DASA schools are responsible for collecting and reporting data regarding material incidents of discrimination, harassment, and bullying.

With this backdrop in mind, we identified three specific projects to work on.

First, we want to conduct a survey (possibly anonymously) of all the DACs in Onondaga County to learn from them how their efforts are going in implementing DASA. Our hope is that this survey will help us pinpoint more concrete ways in which we can assist the DACs in ensuring that DASA's promise is met.

Second, we hope to conduct a detailed survey of the DACs to gather more granular information about their work. Our hope is that this data collection will allow us to identify local best practices in DASA implementation; we can then share this peer information with all DACs.

Third, we want to help education various constituencies about DASA. This includes students and their parents, teachers, and possibility School Boards. To this end, we will work on creating brochures and other materials geared at each different audience.

Medium-term Goal

We have identified two projects that have a longer time-frame. We will work on these simultaneously with our short-term projects.

First, we want to develop materials that will help explain what we mean by Human Rights (or Civil Rights and Civil Liberties). This will involve not only putting together materials on what Human Rights means in the broadest, international context (including as expressed in the United Nations' Declaration on Human Rights). It will also involve some explanation of this concept in the context of national and state law. Once these materials are presented, we can not only use them on our Commission's website, but perhaps in other educations materials.

Second, we want to explore how to bring Human Rights education into classrooms in Onondaga County. We realize that some instruction about Human Rights is part of the Common Core curriculum for 10th grade students. We want to explore how we can supplement this, perhaps by providing such education at earlier ages (elementary and middle schools).

Long-term Goal

We have identified one long-term goal, one we have called the Amongst Us Project. The purpose is to find a way to celebrate members of our community who are working to promote human rights (broadly defined) on a local level. We had Starr Guckert in mind as we were thinking of this.

We know there are many awards that are given by civics organizations every year. We don't want to duplicate that by having just another awards ceremony. Rather, what we hope to do is to find a way in which every small part of the community celebrates folks amongst that community.
