# ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION COMMITTEE MINUTES – NOVEMBER 14, 2023 DEBRA J. CODY, VICE CHAIR

Vice Chair Cody called the meeting to order at 1:49 p.m. and the previous meeting's minutes were approved.

- 1. WATER ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION: Ben Yaus, Senior Deputy County Attorney
  - a. Authorizing the County Executive to Enter into a Utility Work Agreement with the New York State Department of Transportation for Highway and Bridge Improvements
- 2 physical infrastructure departments ~ WEP and DOT get requests from the State
- Whenever state does roads, a right-of-way or doing an improvement project, and need to move utility line; will offer to move/install at state's expense
- Need HC140-utility work agreement, acknowledges that state will move it
- Done on a project by project basis

### **Questions/Comments from committee:**

- State pays for work being done
- Where is the exact location of this?
  - o Location is by Henry Clay where it crosses 481 (Mud Creek runs under it)
- Is it moving something from someplace to another?
  - O Yes, cut off or pull up a pipe; reinstall or relocate it
  - o Most utilities are usually in road right-of-way
  - o Utility company like National Grid uses this utility corridor
  - o 481 highway bridge improvement to bridge over Mud Creek
- Has there been any environmental testing in northern, eastern, Jamesville Dewitt or in the city?
  - o The County has not been a part of that
  - o Believe approvals have been done and this is clearing the way for it
  - o Routine process; the state will do it and pay for it
