WHEREAS, Legislator Tassone was predeceased by her husband Bill and son Eric, and left to cherish her memory are her two sons, Ben and Chris, along with their wives, eight grandchildren, seven siblings and dozens of nieces and nephews; now, therefore be it

AUTHORIZING "MANAGEMENT CONFIDENTIAL PAID TIME OFF (MC-PTO)" FOR ALL MANAGEMENT CONFIDENTIAL NEWLY HIRED EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, in recent times, the County has encountered difficulties recruiting for various management confidential positions, and such difficulty is due, in part, to the County's policy regarding Paid Time Off for newly hired employees in their first year of employment; and

WHEREAS, under the current Vacation Leave Policy, amended by Resolution No. 181-2010, the Vacation Leave Policy for newly hired management confidential employees allows, that during the initial year of employment, vacation leave shall be earned and credited during the course of the initial year, and such leave shall be available for use by the employee as such leave is earned and credited during the course of that initial year, rather than earned, credited and available for use on the employee's anniversary date; and

WHEREAS, although this policy allows the use of vacation leave in the first year, any time taken reduces the employee's vacation time available in their second year of employment; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that all newly hired regular full-time and regular part-time (on a pro rata basis) management confidential employees who are not represented by a bargaining unit through a recognized labor organization and are working in management confidential titles (collectively, "management confidential employees") shall be granted five (5) days of Paid Time Off (PTO) upon hire; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that any unused portion of the five (5) days of PTO shall expire when the employee is credited with earned and unused vacation and personal accruals (Fringe Benefit date); and, be it further

RESOLVED, that should a management confidential employee leave the employ of Onondaga County, unused PTO time shall be forfeited and shall not be paid out or converted to cash or other benefits; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that Resolution No. 181-2010, as supplemented hereby, shall remain in full force and effect; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that this resolution shall take effect for those employees hired into management confidential positions on or after July 1, 2025.

AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF A SETTLEMENT FOR A CLAIM FILED AGAINST THE COUNTY OF ONONDAGA

WHEREAS, on or about November 17, 2021, a claim was filed with Onondaga County by Justin L. Wright (Plaintiff) against the Onondaga County Sheriff's Office alleging unlawful detention; and

WHEREAS, on or about August 1, 2022, Plaintiff filed a Summons and Complaint seeking compensatory and punitive damages against the County stemming from Plaintiff's purported unlawful detention; and

WHEREAS, the case proceeded to trial and, on February 27, 2025, a jury returned a verdict in Plaintiff's favor for \$40,000.00 in past, and \$450,000.00 in future, compensatory damages, for a total award of \$490,000.00; and

WHEREAS, after the jury verdict was issued, the County moved the court to set aside the verdict, and thereafter the parties entered settlement discussions wherein, on or about May 5, 2025, Plaintiff accepted the County's offer of \$267,647.80 in full settlement of Plaintiff's claims; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the County Attorney is hereby authorized to settle this claim in the amount of \$267,647.80, and the Comptroller be and hereby is authorized to draw his warrant charging it against the proper funds; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that this warrant shall be released to the County Attorney upon receipt of the proper Release.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 260 of June 5, 1978, adopted pursuant to Section 11.82 of the Onondaga County Administrative Code, the County Legislature dissolved all existing Sanitary and Treatment Plant Districts of the County and established as successor thereto, the Onondaga County Sanitary District, effective January 1, 1979; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Water Environment Protection of said County, pursuant to the Onondaga County Administrative Code, has prepared and submitted to said County Legislature, a report dated June 12, 2025 (the "Report"), duly approved by the County Executive, in connection with proposed improvements to the Onondaga County Sanitary District consisting of the following:

- a. Comprehensive Asset Renewal at Meadowbrook Limestone WWTP \$11,000,000
- b. Department-Wide Mechanical, Electrical & Process Improvements \$2,275,000
- c. Department-Wide Building & Site Improvements \$2,425,000
- d. Ley Creek/Liverpool Force Main Rehabilitation \$10,300,000
- e. Metro WWTP 1978 Plant Annex Asset Renewal \$14,700,000
- f. Wastewater Transportation System Improvements \$15,050,000
- g. Metro Thickener Project increase cost from \$4,730,000 to \$5,730,000

WHEREAS, it is now desired to call a Public Hearing in connection with such sewer improvements, all in accordance with the provisions of the Onondaga County Administrative Code; now, therefore be it

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A CONSENT ORDER RELATIVE TO THE SETTLEMENT OF AN ENFORCEMENT ACTION BROUGHT BY THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION

WHEREAS, by Notice of Violation dated September 5, 2024, the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) informed Onondaga County that the DEC would be initiating an enforcement action against the County for violating certain Environmental Conservation Laws, associated regulations, and its Syracuse Metropolitan Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) State Pollution Discharge Elimination System (SPDES) permit on account of specified sanitary sewer overflows (SSO) along the Freeman Avenue Trunk Sewer; and

WHEREAS, the County and DEC seek to enter into a Consent Order (Case No.: R7-20250328-16) to settle this matter, a copy of which Order is on file with the Clerk of this Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the Consent Order provides for the County to fund an Environmental Benefit Project (EBP), i.e., the Onondaga Watershed Investigation and Remediation Projects/Tully Valley Mud Boil Remediation Project, in the amount of \$40,000.00 payable to the Central New York Regional Planning and Development Board (CNYRPDB) and to pay the DEC a sum not to exceed \$100,000.00, \$10,000.00 of which is a payable penalty due upon execution and \$90,000.00 of which is suspended and will not become due in the event of the timely and successful completion of the items set forth in the compliance schedule attached to said Order, including: installation of flow meters, grinder pumps and bolt-down manhole covers; submission of a basis of design engineering report and implementation schedule for capital infrastructure project(s) to address hydraulic capacity constraints existing in the trunk sewer; timely completion of all items and milestones set forth in the approved implementation schedule; and interim reporting; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the County to enter into said proposed Consent Order; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the County Attorney is authorized to settle said action for a sum not to exceed \$140,000.00, consisting of a \$40,000.00 EBP, \$10,000.00 payable penalty, and \$90,000.00 suspended penalty, and that the Comptroller be and hereby is authorized to draw his warrant, charging it against the proper funds; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Onondaga County Executive hereby is authorized to execute said Consent Order on file with the Clerk of this Legislature resolving this matter, and to execute such further documents to implement the terms of the Consent Order and to carry out the intent of this resolution.

RESOLUTION NO. 83

AUTHORIZING THE OFFICE OF THE ENVIRONMENT TO APPLY FOR NEW YORK STATE CLIMATE SMART COMMUNITIES GRANT FUNDING AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS TO IMPLEMENT THIS RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the State of New York has established the Climate Smart Communities Grant Program pursuant to Environmental Conservation Law Article 54, Title 15 and made funding available to local governments thereunder via a grant application process; and

WHEREAS, Onondaga County hereby requests financial assistance from the State under such grant program and certifies that it has identified \$75,000 of matching funds from its general fund, as appropriated in the 2025 County Budget, pursuant to the requirements of the Climate Smart Communities Grant Program and Environmental Conservation Law Article 54, Title 15; and

WHEREAS, under Subtitle B of Title IV of the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 11371 et seq.), the U. S.
